Reporting Changes & Your Review

Reporting Changes:

Did you move? Did your income or housing costs change? Has anyone joined or left your household? Your copy of the "Agreement to Report Change" form you signed says what you need to do if you get 3SquaresVT benefits.

- ◆ Most 3SquaresVT households only need to report changes in income when it goes over the 130% income limit shown on the back of the "Agreement to Report Changes" form.
- ◆ However, households that also get benefits from Reach Up, Medicaid, Dr. Dynasaur, Essential Person or Vermont Health Access (VHAP) have to report changes within 10 days.
- ◆ To get a Change Report form, call Economic Services 1-800-479-6151
- ◆ After Economic Services processes your report, they will send you a letter describing any changes to your benefit amount.

Your Review:

- ◆ Most households need to have a review every 12 months to continue to receive 3SquaresVT benefits. Seniors and people with disabilities may get benefits up to 24 months before a review is needed.
- ◆ You will get a notice from the Economic Services Division along with an application for recertification in the mail 5 or 6 weeks before your final month on the program.
- ◆ Fill out all necessary forms and mail them back to your 3SquaresVT worker. Your worker will then contact you about your review appointment.

Please note: If you do not return your review forms to your 3SquaresVT worker by the 15th of the final month of your certification period, your benefits may be interrupted.
